



Have you ever started a field sketchbook but ended up with incomplete pages and inconsistent entries? This class with botanist Lara Call Gastinger will teach basic plant identification, how to observe and document plants, and how to successfully maintain a sketchbook.

Supply List

- Bring a blank sketchbook. The page size should be at least 8 ½ x11 inches. I suggest bringing a sketchbook that has heavy paper that can handle watercolor. Please make sure it is smooth (HOT) press.
- HB pencil
- Micron 01 pen
- Portable watercolor brush (water brushes are good options)
- Portable watercolor travel set (optional since I will have some paint too)
- Small jar for water
- Anything to make you feel comfortable outside - hat, sunscreen, sunglasses, etc.
